Volunteers who teach, mentor and advise Harpswell's bright young women attending university. They live in Harpswell's two dormitory leadership centers with the students for three to six months.

Women who want to share, broaden and deepen their international and cultural experiences. They are strong English speakers, natural learners and teachers who are fierce advocates for gender equality.

Sisters who form lasting relationships with and play a significant role in shaping the next generation of leaders of Cambodia. Many continue their mentorship of students long after their time in Phnom Penh and frequently return to the dorms as visitors.
